Paul finally interrupts, "You guys realize that we've exiled Bruce to Massachusetts, where he no doubt communes with whatever forbidden gods his people found in the seas, and that Tim has fled to the Southwest where he revels in psychedelic artworks and out-of-body experiences? Even further, this entire exchange is completely fictional. Do you seriously think that any of these quotes sound like any of us? We have been made puppets of the author once again. Don't you feel the chill weight of his dead hands upon your shoulders?"

The others shudder and lose 1D6 SAN. *Tim* is too far away – he is safe. And as for *Bruce*, the less said about his fate the better.

#### Hero Point Bonuses

Each character has five Hero Points to assign to bonuses for the session.

#### The Bondi Beach Brawlers

- *Nightwalker* KDI family member, traumatized by time in the Hul dimension, has a pneumatic arm spike and a swinging grapple line. The leader.
- Feral Juggernaut kid superhero in training, junk yard gadgets and brawling (real name: Rupert Jagger)

- Wisp Nightwalker's new girlfriend, turns into mist? or turns invisible? We're not really sure.
- The Gecko agile, wall walking, chameleon, and uses guns.
- Cosmotron the cosmic spirit that briefly possessed Dynamo Joe, now housed in a flesh-bot duplicate of Umbral/Abyssal (real name: ሀያሪ⊑ ቐ አ የአሪ)

Note: the fact that Cosmotron looks like the now-villainous Umbral shouldn't cause any problems in the future. What are the odds?

## **Breaking Beach Conduct Standards**

The *Yowie* takes the *Bondi Beach Brawlers* to Bondi Beach allegedly for fun but really to get them in a fight with the local beach bodybuilders while only wearing their swimmers (the correct NSW term for bathing suits. Not NSFW, New South Wales.) His justification is that this will "butch them up Charles Atlas style." The beach is busy because it's a long weekend for Reconciliation Week. A youth (16-24) MC and DJ event is going on and is playing something a lot like the Japanese band "Babymetal."

It turns out that villain Fright Train is there lifting weights (it turns out he got released from prison on some Suicide Squad-type leave) and it turns into *Overwatch, Golden Key,* and Yowie standing by to subtly boost/hinder them while Nightwalker, The Wisp, Feral Juggernaut, Cosmotron, and The Gecko get tossed around a while but then eventually rally to KO Fright Train!

After their victory, Yowie bundles the Brawlers into the van to bail before the jacks arrive.

### Some Light Theft to Please Ermine

Golden Key (no doubt "disguised" as *Black Clavis*), Yowie, and Overwatch help *Ermine* to steal a quantity of perestroikaium (a rare earth metal first refined by Gorbachev-era science comrades) from the villain *Mecha-Stalin*. Ethical considerations don't apply, because whatever Ermine hopes to do with the stuff is obviously not as bad as what the Soviet revanchist villain intends.

As a side bonus, the heroes hold on to one crate of the mineral so it can be used to convert *El Genio's* hovercraft into a flying car. El Genio (who was prevented from joining the event by a previous engagement) is tremendously grateful.

### **End of the Session**

The session ends with the characters in possession of a crate of perestroikaium and the Bondi Beach Brawlers rather tougher than they had been before. Anybody's guess how many Hero Points the group accumulated in the process.
